PRIVATE MUSIC INSTRUCTION CONTRACT

1. _____, herein after referred to as the student, will receive a ____ minute lesson once a week at a cost of _____ per month. There will be a total of 42 lessons during the year. Payment for lessons is to be made monthly and is due on the 1st of the month. Payments can be mailed to:

2. The student will receive a bill (which outlines the anticipated dates of the lessons) by the first lesson of the month, IF REQUESTED.

3. If the payment is postmarked after the tenth of the month, a late fee of \$15.00 per student will be assessed. Payments received by mail will receive a late fee if postmarked after the tenth. This late fee will be added to the next month's bill if it is not included with the payment.

4. Every effort will be made to see the student each week. If the teacher must cancel for any reason and is unable to reschedule, a credit will be issued on the next month's bill. If the student needs to cancel a lesson, inform the teacher of the conflict as soon as possible. The first option is to reschedule the lesson. If it is not possible to reschedule the lesson, you will still be responsible for payment. Any cancellations received on the day of the lesson will not be rescheduled. This includes a "no show" lesson. The only exceptions are inclement weather and emergencies.

5. The most vital element in learning a musical instrument is Consistent Practice. The **minimum** practice time goal is **20 minutes, 6 days a week**. Occasionally, there will be weeks of irregular practice due to illness, vacations, etc., but the student is expected to maintain this minimum (or more) faithfully.

6. Most lessons are scheduled back to back, therefore, it is of utmost importance that the student be **ON TIME** for the lesson.

7. It is **VERY DIFFICULT** to work without music. Be sure to bring the assigned music to every lesson. Also, the student should bring any other materials requested by the teacher. All music must be purchased by the student, although the teacher may order, or pick up the music as needed.

8. New lesson schedules are made as needed.

By signing this contract, the student is committing to lessons on a month to month basis. In other words, if the student terminates lessons, it must occur at the end of the month. Any money that has been paid in advance will not be refunded if the student chooses to terminate lessons in the middle of the month.
