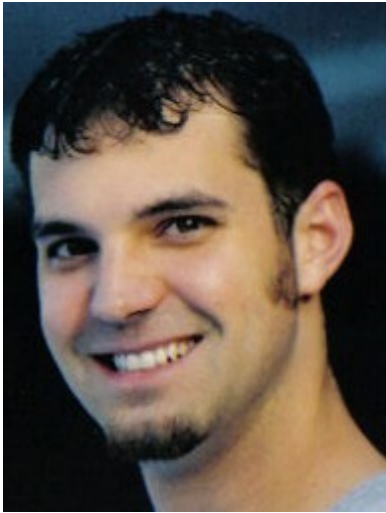


Tom Panepinto, *French Horn*

After graduation Tom spent two years free lancing in Orlando, Florida. As a free lance hornist, Tom has performed with the North Carolina Symphony, North Carolina Opera Company, Capital Opera, Chamber Orchestra of the Triangle, North Carolina Master Chorale, North Carolina Wind Orchestra, Raleigh Symphony Orchestra, Raleigh Civic Symphony, Durham Choral Society, Cary Concert Singers, and the St. Francis Brass Band.
